- I understand that it is ILLEGAL for anyone besides a licensed rehabilitator to keep a wild animal or bird.
- Furthermore, I understand that the attending Veterinarian(s) will treat the animal or bird I have rescued in the most compassionate way at his/ her sole discretion.
- Wild animals that are permanently disabled will be humanely euthanized. WestVet will treat wild animals that can be fully rehabilitated and contact AIDA for rehabilitation candidates.

'DOMESTIC ANIMALS' Authorization for Medical and/or Surgical Treatment:

- I hereby authorize the attending Veterinarian(s) to administer treatment as is considered therapeutically necessary on the basis of medical evaluation. I also consent to the administration of such anesthetics, as are necessary and surgical procedures of any emergency nature.

FAQ's: Why am I being asked for location and contact information?

1. Many symptoms have multiple causes. Specific information such as why and where the animal was found helps rehabilitators determine cause of the injury and the appropriate care.
2. Information on location is needed to return wildlife back to their territory. It helps assure success after release, especially during winter or summer months.
3. Licensed rehabilitators are required by the federal/state government to maintain yearly reports for each animal they receive. Rescuer information and location are required for these reports.
